Annual Report: 2019 - 2020

1. Preamble:

PEAS Trust, Lalgudi are pleased to submit the Annual report of our organization for the year 2019-2020, with a hope and high motivation. We have worked hard to reach more families and women in the target villages of Pullambadi and Lalgudi blocks of Trichy district, during the year our programmes to build of Trichy livelihood and capacities that lead them towards sustainable development. The activities and projects that are implemented during the year under review

1A. Labours Day Celebration:

PEAS trust was celebrated the labours day at public place of Sembarai village, Lalgudi blocks. Around 480 un-organized labours were participated in this celebration Mr. Kennady, Asst labour Welfare Officer, given the special speech among the labours, the end of the programme Mr. P.Kanagavel convey his heartiest thanks to all.

1B. Climate changes awareness programme:

Our PEAS Trust was conducted the one day programme on climate changes awareness at the administrative office premises around 800 Nos of the SHG women and school students were attended the programme. First of all Mrs. P.Kavitha, Co-ordinator of PEAS Trust, welcomed to all the participants and guests. Our eminent resource personas spoke about the following topics.

- > Globel warming
- > Water resources
- > Impacts of ozone layer
- Abuses of plastic things
- > Increase of tree, plants, etc

The participants were gained more knowledge about safe of human life from the climate changes. We distributed the hand bills and pamphlet to the participants. The end of the programme Mr.P.Kanagavel, Managing trustee convey his thanks to all.

2. Tree plantation awareness programme:

In this Financial year, our PEAS Trust was conducted the Tree plantation awareness programme at Mettupatti, Sembarai, Peruvalanallur, Lalgudi (Tk), Trichy (Dt), our Trust volunteers were participated with very eagerly and distributed the Tree plantation awareness notice to the surrounding villages of Lalgudi block's people. Especially we distributed the Tree saplings to scheduled tribes of Pullambadi formers and SHG women members. Our trust's volunteers, planted the tree saplings, under the head of Mr. P.Kanagavel, Managing trustee, in the important place of panchayat union Officers, Govt.schools etc. We distributed the tree plantation awareness notice which contained, donot cut the trees to get rain. Also the Managing trustee, advised to the participants, large number of tree saplings plant in the back yard of the house and empty lands.

3. Free note books distribution

PEAS Trust is encourage the school children in every year to academic side. In this year we distributed the free Note books, writing material and geometry boxes also to selected poor students as free of cost. It was very useful to them, during the annual examination. The Headmistress, L.N.P. Hr.Sec.School, Lalgudi distributed the note books and advised to the students, hard work to prepare the public exam to get good result with

high marks. Also she spoke about the violence against sexual torture to women and girl child.

4. Clean India awareness progeramme:

PEAS Trust conducted the clean India awareness program at community hall of Mettupatti, Lalgudi (Tk), Trichy (Dt) under the head of Dr.Cheziyan Sakthi Hospital, Lalgudi, M.B.B.S, DGO. He was delivered the message about street clean, health clean, prevention methods of various communicable caste diseases etc. Our trust volunteers distributed the clean India awareness notice to public. We provide the clean India awareness caps to our volunteers. Before started this programme, our volunteers cleaned the streets, and important government offices at Lalgudi. Also we provided the chlorine powder pockets, to slum dwellers.

5. Family Rehabilitation:

In this year we provided the cash grant to poor woman Mrs. Chandra, Mettupatti to purchased and sale the vegetables loke street vendor and another woman Mrs. Marthal, Mettupatti to start the petti shop in front of the primary school. This is very useful to them to promote their socioecanomic developments for their livelihood.

6. Herbal utilization awareness programme:

Nattu marunthe The one day programme on Herbal utilization awareness among the SHG's women member organized by the PEAS Trust. The siddha doctor Mr.Mani, Lalgudi spoke about various herbal pants, herbal medicines and its benefits of the various diseases. Hand bills also distributed to the participants, 400 Nos of the SHG's members attended and gained more knowledge about the herbal plants and its benefits in this awareness program. The end of the programme Kapasura water and Nilavembu juice distributed to all the participants. Also we trained the participant to product the herbal medicine powder.

7. Entrepreneurship development programme:

The entrepreneurship development training was conducted by PEAS trust to the SHG's women members at the administrative office premises. Around 188 Nos.of SHG's women members were participated in this E.D.P training. In this training, our eminent trainers were trained the mosquito coils, candle making, soap oil and computer sambirani etc with help of guideline books distributed to all the trainees. Through this training all the trainees will product the above mentioned material to earn sufficient income for their livelihoods.

8. Campaign against plastic usage:

Our PEAS trust was organized the awareness campaign against the plastic usages. Mr. Kanan, M.Sc., B.Ed, Hr.Sec. School, Lalgudi delivered the messages about the abuses of the plastic usages, like ground water will be spoiled, mass pollution controls, failure of the rain, etc. In this programme 600 Nos.of the men and women and youths were participated. The awareness notice, distributed to the public with help of our volunteers in and around of Lalgudi blocks of Trichy district.

9. Medical Assistance:

Our PEAS trust, helped to the poor patients Mr. Ponnusamy, Siruvayalur as in the stage of very serious conditions. Our trust took the patient to admitted in the hospital and provided the medical treatment to him.

10. Forming the Kitchen garden to schools:

Our PEAS trust, selected the 5 Nos.of primary school in the Lalgudi blocks of Trichy district, to formed the kitchen garden at Mettupatti, Sembarai, Kattur, Ramanathapuram and Poovalur. We planted various vegetables like Brinjal, Tomotto, Ladies finger and Drumstic etc with help of school students under the head of the school headmasters. It is very useful

to midday meals. Also our PEAS trust donated the ceiling fans to every school with the help of well wishers and sponsor.

11. Samathuva pongal celebration:

In this year our PEAS trust celebrated the pongal day with poor aged people of Sirumayangudi village. We provided the sweet pongal to aged people. Our volunteers conducted the dramas and dances in this celebration. All the aged people enjoyed the whole day very nicely.

12. Cultivation training for marginalized farmers:

. PEAS trust conducted the cultivation training with the help of save India, U.S.A to the marginalized farmers. This progeramme was held at Community hall of Peruvalappur, Sirumayankudi, and Vandalai koodalur Mr.Srithar, president, panchayat union, Peruvalapur inaugurated the training. In this training Mr.Kamarajar B.Sc Agri, Pudukkottai spoke about how to form the cultivation and explained by demonstration in front of the trainees Brinjal, Redgram, Tomotto etc plants were cultivated. The kumulur agricultural principal, Mr.Annadurai visited this training programme as a chief guest. During this training various seeds pockets provided to the marginalized farmers. The end of the training Mr.P.Kanagavel expressed about special address and convey his hearteast thanks to all. Also we went to Kumulur Agri college likes goat reary vermin compost products, panchakaviya, destroyed the insets. All the trainees everything noted.

13. Free tailoring training:

PEAS trust runs the skill training centre to the Adolescent girls from rural families in free tailoring training. 30 girls have been trained per batch to tally 40 girls were trained per year in tailoring. The girls trainees have been helped to do their cutting, sewing, embroidery and hand works during the training period and they were helped to find placements with the export garments, tailoring shops and also putup their own shop using the bank loans.

14. Free tuition classes:

Our PEAS trust conducting the evening tuition classes for poor students in every year at Mettupatti Village. In this year 62 poor students were benefited by our tuition centre. Our eminent tuition teachers were taught all subjects especially Maths, English and Science subjects. Weekly and monthly tests were conducted regularly. We found the weak students, we give the special attention to them. In this year all students were got result with high marks with the help of our tuition teachers.

15. Job related computer training:

In this year PEAS trust started the Job-related computer centre for the youths, unemployed graduators and school students. In this computer education we given the basic computer, operated the typing methods, MS-Word and Java etc. Around 85 youths were benefited by this computer training. Many of the youths got the job in private sector like billing section, data entry offices and private banks etc with sufficient income for their families.

Roll of the PEAS Trust - Un organised labours welfare activities

Our PEAS Trust helped to Un-organized labour following schemes.

- Government scholoarship grant was receved to Xth, XII and College, Technical college students through Tamilnadu government more than 1750 students were benefited by our trust PEAS trust.
- 2. Funeral grant received from the government worth Rs.25,000/- to 40 Nos of th Un-organized labours.

- '3. In this year, we helped to Un-organized labour's daughter were benefited by marriage welfare fund from the government, around 115 Nos were benefitted.
- 4, PEAS trust was conducted the eye camp at the administrative office premises to un-organized labour. Also we provided the spex (கண் கண்ணாடி) to them by the government fund.
- 5. Free sewing machines provided to widows, neglected and depressed women, orphan and semi orphan adolescent girls from the District Social Welfare board, Trichy by PEAS trust.
- **6.** In this year un-organized penson monthly Rs.1000/- received from the government by the PEAS trust in every month. Around 150 above unorganized 60 aged above retired labour.
- 7. Corona Activities: The corono fund, Rs.2,000/- free food provisions, supplied from the government ration shop with the help of our PEAS trust, around 3500 Nos.of un-organized labour were benefitted.
